Cru and Ratio Christi to Host “I Don’t Have Enough Faith to Be an Atheist” Event at UNL

January 6, 2020 (Lincoln, Neb.) – Cru and Ratio Christi have invited Frank Turek to present his lecture “I Don’t Have Enough Faith to Be an Atheist” on Tuesday, February 25, 2020, at 8:00pm in the Centennial Room at the Nebraska Student Union. The event is free to the public and will include a 45-minute audience Q&A after the lecture.

Cru and Ratio Christi, both campus ministries at UNL, are proud to partner together to host the event. Turek, a nationally renowned author, Christian apologist, and radio host, is best known as the founder and president of the apologetics ministry Cross Examined. He has authored two books in addition to co-authoring two others with theologian Norman Geisler. Turek’s lecture at UNL will be based on his book of the same title.

“I’m thrilled that we could bring in someone like Frank to speak at the University,” said Wesley Farewell, Director of Ratio Christi at UNL. “Not only is Frank incredibly intelligent and well-versed in world religions and philosophy, he’s an exciting, engaging, and entertaining speaker.”

The event is expected to reach capacity in the Centennial Room, which holds 700 people. An overflow room with a livestream will be available. Those watching from home can view the event live on Cross Examined’s YouTube page.

“If students want to experience this in person, we’d encourage them to show up early,” Farewell said. “This is an event you will not want to miss.”
